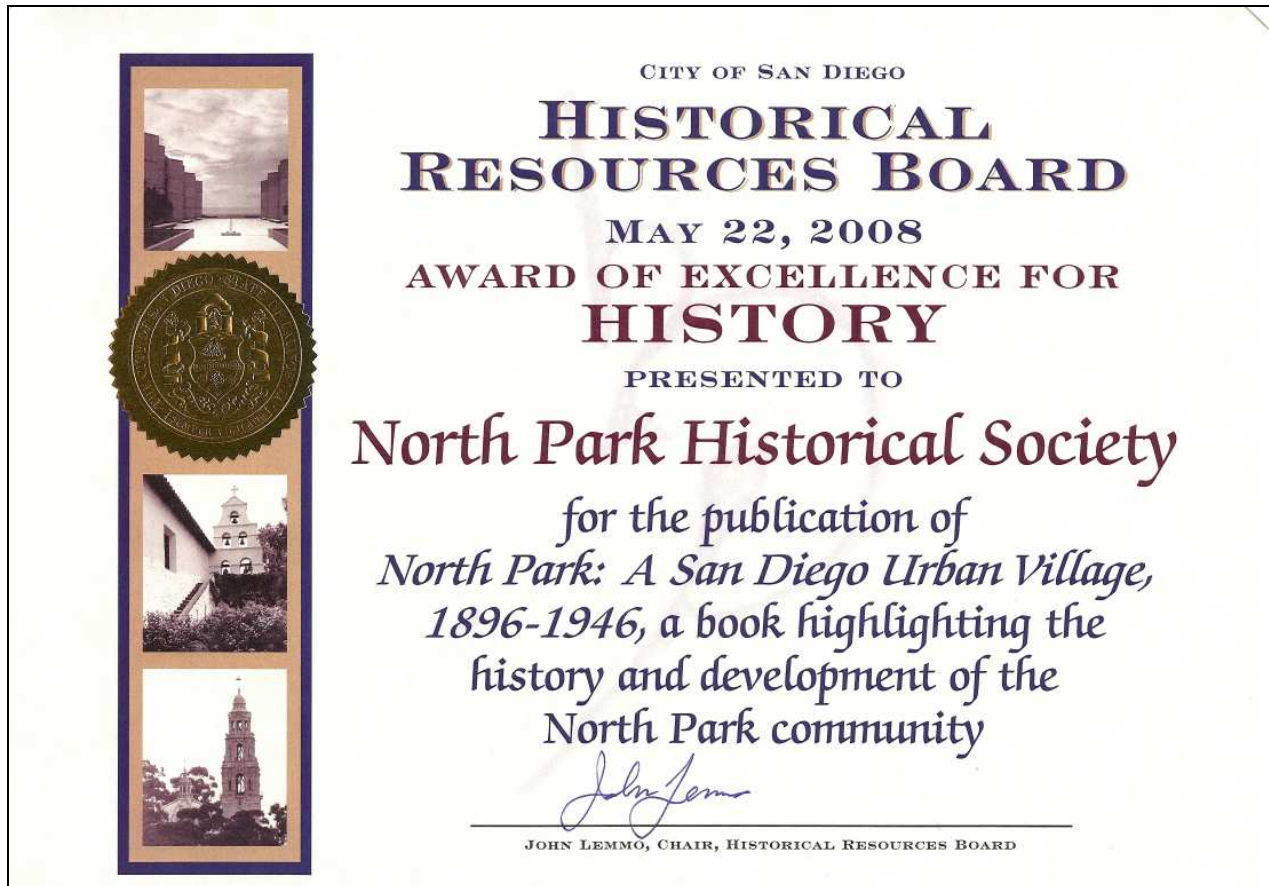


NORTH PARK'S HISTORY BOOK HONORED



North Park's engaging history book received high honors from the City of San Diego Historical Resources Board on May 22, 2008 at the Annual Awards for Excellence in Historic Preservation. North Park: A San Diego Urban Village, 1896-1946 by the late Don Covington achieved the Award for History. The new North Park Historical Society, editor/publisher Katherine Hon, Karon Covington, and Don Covington (in memoriam) were cited by the HRB and were honored with a Special Commendation from Councilmember Toni Atkins for their work. In accepting the award, Katherine Hon, Secretary of the North Park Historical Society's 12-member Board, presented a copy of the book to Ken Kramer, host of the NBC 7/39 show "About San Diego." Kramer was present to receive an award for Education. Hon said she hoped he "would find many interesting stories about a unique corner of San Diego – North Park."
